A meeting was held in the Bowl House on Monday 16th March at 7.30 when there were present Messrs Macfarlane, Nicholson and Ridley as President, Vice President and Secretary, respectively of the Kilmarnock Bowling Club along with Messrs Wilson, Warden & W. Carroll as Vice President, Secretary & Treasurer, and Match Secretary, Miss Isobel Wood, Messrs Arnour and Wood as members of Committee of the Yarnis Section

Business

The following were drawn up to constitute the Rules & Regulations of the Kilmarnock Bowling Club - Yarnis Section.

1. The club shall be known as the Kilmarnock Bowling Club - Yarnis Section
2. The officials appointed annually shall be President, Vice President, Secretary & Treasurer, Match Secretary and other four members of committee.
3. When it is necessary to call a general meeting of the club each member shall

receive intimation by post card from the Secretary and it shall be held that eight members present at a meeting so called shall constitute a quorum of the Club and it shall be competent to them to carry through all business in connection therewith.

4. The subscriptions for season 1936 shall be Seniors 25/- and Juniors 4/6 and must be paid within 30 days of opening of courts. Balls will be supplied and the Committee are empowered to fix and impose annually a levy on senior members to cover the cost of same.

5. The hours of play for Juniors will be till 6 pm. on weekdays and till 1 pm. on Saturdays.

6. Members wishing to play shall enter their names on the board provided for the purpose and shall play in that order. Ladies Quits doubles may be made up provided their names are in consecutive

order. Names must be entered by the party in person together with time of starting set.

7. If members are waiting to play those occupying courts must leave same at the end of an ordinary set. The maximum time allowed for an ordinary set is twenty minutes and the players shall be bound to leave the courts at the expiry of that time whether the set has been completed or not. The time shall be noted from the clock in the clubhouse. When tournaments are arranged the courts shall be at the disposal of the committee.

8. Members may introduce a friend six times during the season. No visitors shall be allowed to play unless accompanied by a member who must enter visitor's name in Visitors Book.

9. When vacancies occur, applicants for membership shall write personally to the secretary, who shall submit same to.

the Committee, the Committee having power to fill vacancies.

10. No person shall enter courts while play is in progress.

11. No person shall at any time trespass on the Bowling Green.

12. For the purpose of suggesting improvements or laying before the Club substantial complaints the signatures of eight members on petition to the Secretary will be sufficient to call a General Meeting.
